MARKET SUMMARY


The Ghana Stock Exchange (GSE) experienced a significant growth in the trading week of January 06-January 10, 2024. The exchange saw 467,238 shares traded, valued at GH¢ 12,568,068.17. This marks a significant increase in turnover of 245.36% from the previous week. The market capitalization currently stands at GH¢ 111.74 billion. During the week, three stocks posted gains, while one recorded loss.


MTNGH led the top five equities with 239,557 shares traded, followed by CAL (134,491), RBGH (31,043), GLD (29,668) and ETI (25,886).

EQUITY ON FOCUS:

Republic Bank Ghana Limited - RBGH

Republic Bank Ghana is the 11th most traded stock on the Ghana Stock Exchange over the past three months (Oct 09, 2024 – Jan 10, 2025). RBGH has traded a total volume of 107,270 shares valued at GH¢ 69,072 over the period, with an average of 1,703 traded shares per session. A volume high of 34,623 was achieved on October 29th for the same period.

GSE INDEX PERFORMANCE. Analysing the performance of GSE market indices, the benchmark GSE Composite Index (GSE-CI) rose by 12.60 points, closing at 4,902.87 points, with a year-to-date gain of 0.29%. Also, the GSE Financial Stocks Index (GSE-FSI) surged by 2.72 points, closing at 2,385.96 points, with a year-to-date gain of 0.22%.


